

14. Sir Anthony Musgrave, G.C.M.G., *b.* 1828, *d.* 1888. Colonial Secretary of Antigua : Administrator of Nevis : Lieut.-Governor of St. Vincent 1862 : Governor of Newfoundland 1864, of British Columbia, of Natal, of South Australia, of Jamaica 1877 to 1882 : and of Queensland 1883 till his death in 1888. During his Governorship of Jamaica he carried through the following measures : the regulation of Coolie Immigration ; the reform of Legal Procedure ; the establishment of Electric Telegraphs ; the Purchase and extension of the Railway ; the founding of the Institute of Jamaica ; the re-organization of the Public Gardens ; the remodelling of the Educational Establishments ; the consolidation of the Public Debt ; and the establishment of a Steam Coastal Service.
