# Wedding

Governor-General, the Most Hon. Sir Florizel Glasspole and Lady Glasspole will leave Jamaica on July 20 for the United Kingdom, the Gleaner has learnt.

Their Excellencies will be attending the Royal Wedding of Prince Charles and Lady Diana Spencer, to which they have been invited as the Queen's representatives in Jamaica.

Sir Florizel will also be formally made a Grand Commander of the Order of St. Michael and St. George by Her Majesty the Queen during his ten-day visit to the U.K. Their Excellencies return on Thursday, July 30.

During Sir Florizel's absence, the Hon. W. V. Parnell, Senior Custos and Custos Rotulorum of Trelawny, will act as Deputy.

The Governor-General and Lady Glasspole will return to Jamaica in time to fulfil two major engagements. The first is a parade at Up Park Camp in Kingston on July 31 to mark the anniversary of the establishment of the Jamaica Defence Force and the second is the Governor-General's Ball at King's House on the night of August 1.
