THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL:

On June 27, 1973, His Excellency the Most Honourable Florizel Augustus Glasspole, O.N., C.D., was sworn-in at King's House as Governor-General of Jamaica. He is the son of the late Rev. Theophilus Glasspole, who was a Methodist Minister. He was educated at Wolmer's School and Ruskin College, Oxford (British T.U.C. Scholarship). A former Accountant, Trade Unionist and foundation member of the People's National Party, which he represented in Parliament for about 29 consecutive years, Mr. Glasspole was Minister of Education when he retired from active politics in May 1973.

As Governor-General he now resides at King's House with his wife, Her Excellency the Most Honourable Mrs. Glasspole.
