Philip Henry Gosse, the well-known naturalist who was born in 1810, visited Bluefields in Westmoreland in 1844-46 and subsequently published "Birds of Jamaica" (1847 & 1849) and "A Naturalist's Sojourn in Jamaica" (1851), which still remain by far the best popular books on t e natural history of the island. He died in 1.88.

The coloured edition of "Birds of Jamaica" is very rare.
