

## Charles Hyatt for James Bond film

Charles Hyatt, Jamaica's leading actor, currently appearing in Trevor Rhone's 'Two Can Play' at the Way Out Theatre, Jamaica Pegasus, has been cast in the new James Bond film, 'Never Say Never Again.'

This will be Hyatt's first Bond movie, but by no means his first film. Other films to his credit include 'A High Wind in Jamaica', 'Love Thy Neighbor', and 'Cross Plot.'

Charles started his acting career in 1945 and since then his 'Here Comes Charley,' a radio classic, and his 'Dames', in the early pantomimes established him in Jamaica as a brilliant comedian. In England in the early

60s he matured as an actor, and won acclaim for numerous radio, TV and stage performances.

Hyatt goes on location in Nassau, Bahamas during November. He returns to 'Two Can Play' right after filming.
