## Sherlock Award to N. W. Manley

The Guild of Graduates of the University of the West Indies will present the first "Sir Philip Sherlock Award" posthumously to the Rt. Excellent Norman Washington Manley at a dinner to be held at the Hotel Kingston on May 29 beginning at 7:30 p.m.

The "Sir Philip Sherlock Award" was recently instituted

by the Guild of Graduates in recognition of Sir Philip's services in education to the West Indies in general and in particular to the University which he served for twenty-one years having retired last year as Vice Chancellor.

The criteria for the award states that the recipient should be an outstanding personality who has contributed not only to the public life of his own country but also to the U.W.I. and the Guild of Graduates.

The first award is being made to the Rt. Excellent Norman Manley who is a National Hero of Jamaica, and who was associated with the University from its inception. In addition he was for some time President of the Guild of Graduates Jamaica Branch.

The presentation will be made by the President of the Jamaica Branch of the Guild, Mr. Ian Ramsay to the widow of the National Hero, Mrs. Edna Manley.

The chairman of the Jamaica Branch Mr. Robert Pickersgill, will chair the function.

The award will be made annually if, in the opinion of the Executive of the Guild and the U.W.I. Council, someone merits it.

**The Leader of the Opposition, Mr. Michael Manley, will reply on behalf of his late father.**

The Prime Minister, Hon. Hugh Shearer, Sir Philip and Lady Sherlock, Prof. Roy Marshall and Mrs. Marshall, as well as representatives from the other Guilds around the Caribbean are expected to attend.
