Toronto paper**

Toronto's "Star Weekly" is publishing on Saturday, December 3, a feature article on the Chief Minister, the Hon. Norman Manley, Q.C., who is described by Emile Lengyel, the writer, as "the record-breaking Chief Minister of Jamaica."

The article traces Mr. Manley's career through the years to his return to leadership of the Jamaica Government and the inception of "Operation New Broom."

After dealing with the economy of the island and the need for "half billion dollars" of new investments, the article turns to Federation and states:
