\$250 art prize

HAVANA, June 2 (AP)—Jamaican artist Albert Huie won a prize of 250 dollars (about £86), today for his painting "Dorothy" entered in the biennial exhibit of Hispanic-America art.

Most of the prizes went to Spanish artists who made up the largest group of exhibitors. They won 26 of the 63 prizes. Cuban artists took 20 prizes.

Argentine artists won five prizes and one each was awarded to artists from England, Venezuela, Phillipines, Panama, Dominican Republic, Bolivia, Brazil, Honduras, Ecuador and Colombia.
