Albert Huie portrays the calm and serene aspects of nature, which he approaches objectively, and not in accordance with the dictates of fashion. His compositions are carefully balanced; their planes and lines creating a harmonious rhythm. He can also capture the subtle muances of the quickly changing light, as it flash es and dies away in the evening, or else as it gradually suffuses the sky early in the morning. Mellow colours applied in small particles produce vib rant textures of great beauty. Mule is also an outstanding port raitist, and his work in this field de-monstrates a penetrating insight into the character of his sitters. "Aunt Fran" is a fine example in this cate gory, and in "Early Morning" on observes a fleeting moment in nature, which has crystallized as if by magic The two pictures were shown in the recent exhibition of the Jamaica Arte and Crafts Society at the State Theatre.
