HAVANA, May 31:

The International Committee of Judges of the second Hispano-American Festival of Art comprised of artists and art critics of Spain, South America and Cuba have awarded an international prize to the Jamaican painter Albert Huie.

Huie's work was among 80 Jamaican paintings sent to Havana in May, to take part in the exhibition which consists of 2,000 paintings and drawings.

Mr. Robert Verity, Supervisor of the Junior Centre who represented Jamaica at the official opening of the exhibition, has been informed of the award in a cable from Senor Alfredo Del-Valle, Minister for Cultural Relations in Havana.
