

This Indenture Quinquepartite made the fifteenth day of July
in the second year of the reigns of His (sic) Sovereign Lady Anne
by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland
Queen Defender of the Faith etc Anno Domini 1703 Anno Regni Domini
1703 Between Hans Sloane of the Parish of St Giles in the Fields
in the County of Middlesex Doctor in Physic and Elizabeth
his wife (late wife of Fulke Rose late of the Parish of St Katharine
in the Island of Jamaica in parts beyond the Seas Esquire deceased)
of the first part Elizabeth Rose of the said Parish of St Giles in the Fields Spinster
(Eldest Daughter of the said Fulke Rose) of the second part John Fuller the
younger of Waldrone in the County of Essex Esquire of the third part Anne
Rose Spinster (Second Daughter of the said Fulke Rose) of the fourth part and
Thomas Lett of the Middle Temple London Gentleman of the fifth part
Whereas the said Fulke Rose man by his last Will and Testament an
writing bearing date the Seven and Twentieth day of October which
was in the year of our Lord One thousand six hundred ninety three
Did give and bequeath unto the said Elizabeth Rose All that his
Plantation of St Thomas in the Vale in the Island of Jamaica
aforesaid commonly called Knolls Plantation with all and every the
Lands therunto belonging and adjoining together with all the
Negroes Mules Cattle Lasses Stills Mills Millhouses and all other
Edifices buildings and all ells whatsoever to the said Plantation
belonging and appertaining to her the said Elizabeth Rose and
her heirs for ever and did also Demise to his said second Daughter
Anne Rose and her heirs forever All that ~~the~~ ^{the} other Plantation
~~she belongs~~ in St Thomas in the Vale commonly called Michleton
Plantation with all his Lands therunto belonging and adjoining
together with all and every the Negroes Mules Cattle Lasses Stills
Mills Millhouses And all other the Edifices buildings and utensils
whatsoever upon the said Plantation being belonging or appertaining
Also he gave and bequeathed unto his said Daughter Anne and
her heirs for ever All his lands at the Maggately called Warrens
Land and Hippolyte Land together with all the stock Negroes and
Cattle upon and belonging to the said Land And did also give and

bequeath unto his said Daughters Elizabeth & Anne and to
their heirs forever All his houses and Lands in the Towne of
St. Iago De Lavaigo as also his Land over the River and
his Lands att the Red Hills both in St. Kathernes Parish
aforesaid Together with all Edifices Buildings Negroes and
Stock upon or belonging to the same and also give and
bequeath unto the said Elizabeth his wife in right of her
Dower the third part of the estate produce and profits of
all his Estate whatsoever during her life as in and by the
said Will Relation being therunto had (among other things)
more fully may appear and whereas the Plantations
aforesaid since the death of the said John Rose have for
divers years past been under one joint Management for the
mutuall benefit and advantage of all persons interested
therin And the persons employed and interested in the
Management for and on behalf of the said Hans Sloane and
Elizabeth his wife (who is intituled to one third part of
the profits of the said Plantations during her life as aforesaid)
and for and on the behalf of the said Elizabeth and Anne
Rose have hitherto managed and improved the same to
the contentment and satisfaction of all parties ~~intended~~ concerned
therin And it is conuined — that for the upholding maintaining
and providing what is necessary for the support and Improvement
of the said Plantations the continuance thereof Subject to and
under a joint Management may be for the future benefit of all
persons who now are or hereafter shall or may be intituled to
the profits and proceeds thereof And in regard the said Elizabeth
Rose and Anne Rose are about to marry Viz the said Elizabeth
Rose with the said John Fuller and the said Anne Rose with the
said ^{Thomas} isted And in case their intended Marriages do take
effect the interest and right of ordering and managing of their
shares of the said Plantations during such marriage will
belong to their respective Husbands Now this Indenture
witnesseth that it is mutually Covenanted Concluded and

agreed by and betwene all and every the said parties to these
presente And each and every of them the said Hans Sloane
and Elizabeth his wife John Fuller Elizabeth Rose Thomas
Isted and Anne Rose for him and herself respectively And for
his and her Executors and Administrators Both severally
and respectively Covenant promise and agree to and with the
other and others of them respectively and his her and their
respective Executors and Administrators That in case the
said Thomas Isted intended Marriages shall take effect
(that is to say) a Marriage intended between the said John
Fuller and Elizabeth Rose And a marriage intended between
the said Thomas Isted and Anne Rose that they the said
Hans Sloane John Fuller and Thomas Isted shall and will
after such Marriages ^{respectively} had and during their respective Estates
and Interests support maintain and uphold the said several
plantations at their own Charge according to their
said several proportions therin and supply the same with
Negroes Stock and Utencils and all things necessary for the
supplying maintaining or improvement of the said several
Plantations in such manner as the same have ^{been} hitherto
supplied and maintained at the charge of the said Hans
Sloane and Elizabeth his wife Elizabeth Rose and Anne Rose
and that neither they the said Hans Sloane and Elizabeth
his wife John Fuller and Elizabeth his intended wife
and Thomas Isted and Anne his intended wife nor any claiming
or to claime by whom or under them respectively without the
mutuall consent of the rest of them shall or will molest hinder
or distract the managing supplying and ordering the said
Plantations in the said Island of Tamaica or the disposing or
settling the products of the same Plantations either in Tamaica
or in England in such manner and by the same Managers
Agents factors and Receivers as the same
have done for divers years last past
* and hath
been done for divers years last past
and interested therein

And that the present Managers Agents Factors or Receivers
 &c for touching or concerning the said Estate — — or any
 of them shall not be removed or displaced without the consent
 of the Majority of the said Parties to these presents Provided
 nevertheless and it is hereby Declared That nothing herein before
 contained shall be construed or taken to debar or hinder them
 the said Hans Sloane and Elizabeth his wife John Fuller
 and Elizabeth his intended wife and Thomas Icted and Anne
 his intended wife or the Major part of them from changing
 or altering any ~~persons~~ now employed under them in the
 Management or ordering of the said Plantations or in the
 disposing or selling the produce or profits arising thereout.
 but they or the Major part of them in the Management
 regarding of the said Plantations or in the disposing or selling
 the produce or profits or during their several estates and
 interests therein shall or may from time to time substitute
 nominate or appoint such person or persons for the management
 thereof either in Jamaica or in England as to them shall
 seem most meet and convenient for that purpose In Witnessse
 whereof the said parties to these presents have thereto
 interchangably set their hands and sealed the day and year
 first above written
