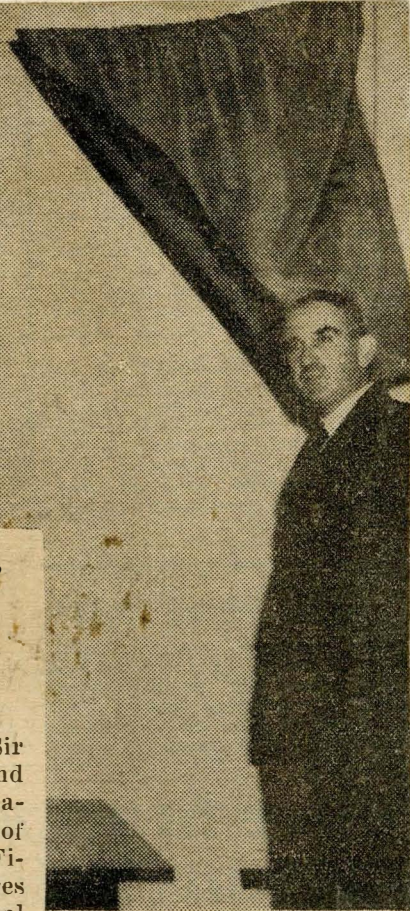

Portrait of Sir Harold Allan is unveiled

A portrait of the late Sir Harold Allan, Kt., founder and late Secretary of the Association of Parochial Boards of Jamaica, and Minister of Finance now adorns the offices of the St. Catherine Parochial Board.

Unveiling of the portrait took place on Saturday afternoon last when the new offices of the Board situated in the Old House of Assembly were formally opened by the Hon' W. A. Bustamante, Chief Minister.

At the brief ceremony which formed part of the proceedings, Mr. Tacius N. Golding, M.H.R., Chairman of the Board, was chairman. Unveiling of the portrait was done by the Hon. Capt. Henry McGrath, Custos of the parish.

"It is with great pleasure that I unveil this portrait of a great Jamaican", Capt. McGrath said in removing the cover from the picture.

Among those who saw the ceremony were Mr. E. Segre, Lewis, current president of the Association of Parochial Boards; Mr. R. D. G. Lewars, Secretary of the St. Catherine Board; Mr. L. W. Rose, M.H.R., members of the Board and representatives of other Parochial Boards.
