Edwin Allen new Leader of Opposition business

Opposition Leader Edward Seaga has appointed North-west Clarendon M.P. Edwin Allen Leader of the Opposition's business in the House of Representatives.

When the House met yesterday Speaker Ripton Macpherson congratulated Mr. Allen. Mr. Munn also congratulated the Opposition Business Leader.

Mr. Allen succeeds Roy McNeill who has given up the post on the ground of ill health. Mr. Allen has been a member of the House since 1950 and has been Minister of Education in two previous JLP Governments.

He noted the performance of previous Opposition Business Leaders and said he hoped to continue the tradition.

But when the House rose at the end of yesterday's sitting the Opposition benches were empty. Mr. Allen was the last to leave after debating the Bill amending the Betting Gaming and Lotteries Act.
