McKenley off to coaches clinic today

HERB McKENLEY, Supervisor of Athletics, leaves the island this afternoon by AVIANCA to attend the first-ever International Track and Field Athletic Coaches conference and clinic at Berkeley, California, from June 11-23.

He has been invited to be the chief guest speaker to over 750 coaches. His subject will be "The Quarter Mile" — a topic on which he is eminently qualified to speak, being at one time holder of the world 440-yard and metric quarter records, He lost the 400-metre mark to another Jamaican, George Rhoden but still has the 440-yard mark at 46 seconds flat.

McKenley during his amateur career won the American National quarter mile championships and several Europ-

ean titles.

But perhaps his greatest feat is that he has run the quarter under 47 seconds —the accepted big-time level, more often than all the other quarter milers of history put together.
