Sir Florizel accepted the invitation during a courtesy call at King's House by a delegation from the organization recently.

Partners of the Americas is a private, non-profit organization with headquarters in Washington DC which links the citizens of 44 U.S. States with those of 21 Latin American and Caribbean countries. There are currently fifty such partnerships.

The partnerships mobilize individual and institutional resources and talents to work cooperatively on technical and cultural projects in areas such as agriculture, education, rehabilitative medicine, sports and community development.

Jamaica has maintained an active partnership with Buffalo, New York, over the past eight years.
