## return from royal wedding

GOVERNOR GENERAL, the Most Hon. Sir Florizel Glasspole and Lady Glasspole, returned to Jamaica from London, yesterday afternoon where they had been guests at the wedding of Prince Charles and Princess Diana.

Tuesday afternoon the day before the wedding, Sir Florizel was invested with the insignia of Knight Grand Cross of the Order of St. Michael and St. George, by Queen Elizabeth II, at Buckingham Palace.

When they arrived at the Norman Manley International Airport yesterday, Sir Florizel displayed the insignia and medals which he received from the Queen, and which form part of his formal attire.

In England, Sir Florizel and Lady Glasspole had a busy itinerary. They met and addressed the staff of the Jamaican High Commission. They also attended receptions hosted by the Lignum Vitae Club of which Mrs. Ernest Peart, wife of the Jamaican High Commissioner, is head of the organising committee.

Sir Florizel addressed the Association of Jamaica in the United Kingdom, and the UK Chapter of the Wolmer's Old Boys Association, on conditions in Jamaica.

Sir Florizel also met members of the West India Committee and leaders of the National Children's Home.

The Glasspoles were guests of honour, along with the President of Trinidad and Tobago, Sir Ellis Clarke, at Vickers DaCosta and Company. Later, they attended a reception at the Commonwealth Secretariat, hosted by Mr. Shridath Ramphal, the Secretary General.

On July 28, Sir Florizel was presented with an issue

of stamps commemorating the wedding of Prince Charles and Princess Diana, at Harroson and Sons Limited.

The Governor General and his party viewed the pre-wedding fireworks display on Tuesday afternoon. They attended at St. Paul's Cathedral on Wednesday morning the dazzling wedding ceremony. Sir Florizel and Lady Glasspole lunched with Prime Minister Mrs. Margaret Thatcher and her husband at the Bank of England after the ceremony.

Arriving with Sir Florizel and Lady Glasspole yesterday was Capt. Morais Kerpens-Lee ADC to the Governor General. On hand to meet the Governor General was his Deputy, the Hon. W. V. Parnell, Mr. John Drinkall, British High Commissioner to Jamaica and Dean of the Diplomatic Corps, Mr. Clinton Hewan, Deputy Chief of Protocol, Chief-of-Staff of the Jamaica Defence Force, Brigadier Robert Neish, Mr. Neville Smith, Secretary to the Governor General, and members of the Staff of King's House.
