Lot 68 in an auction sale held at Hodgson and Co., Chancery Lane, London, on 29 June 1967 was described in the catalogue as:

JAMAICA - SIX MATER-COLOUR DRAWINGS, being Views of Estates belonging to G. Watson Taylor, M.P.: (1) Holland Estate, St. Thomas in the East, Jamaica, (2) Mill Yard, Holland Estate, (3) Lyssons Estate, (4) Holland Estate: View from the Change of Air House, (5) Llanrumney Estate, St. Mary's, and (6) Haughton Court, Hanover; ca. 16" x 12", mounted on thick paper, in a folio volume, green morocco extra, gilt inner borders; early nineteenth century.

These six drawings are included (under the name of G. Watson Taylor) in the List of Drawings in Hakewill's <u>Picturesque Tour</u>, and No. (1) is the one reproduced in the book. The Llanrumney drawing is a view of the sugar works, with cane-cutting in progress in the foreground. The set was purchased for stock, for £760, by the art dealers, Frank T. Sabin, 9 Albemarle St., London W. 1.
