

HUIE PAINTING FOR STUDENTS' CENTRE

THE Board of Governors of the Institute of Jamaica has obtained "West Indian Girl" by Albert Huie for presentation to the West Indian Students Centre recently opened in London at No. 1 Collingham Gardens, Kensington, S.W. 5.

The painting, which has been provided with a suitable silver inscription plate, will be forwarded to the United Kingdom within the next few weeks.

The purpose of the West Indian Students Centre is to provide for all West Indian students in the United Kingdom a social club where they may feel at home, and where they can organise social and cultural activities, meet their friends, and entertain guests.

The West Indian Governments contribute toward the cost of maintaining the Centre, which is open to all students from the contributing territories on payment of a small subscription.

The Board of Governors of the Centre is anxious that in the furnishing of the Centre every possible means should be employed to make the rooms representative of the mode of life and culture of the people of the British Caribbean territories.
