PREFACE

The *Jamaican National Bibliography* aims to list all materials published in Jamaica, works by Jamaicans published outside of the country, as well as works about Jamaica, to describe each work in detail, and to give the subject matter of each work.

The material catalogued is based on items received in the National Library of Jamaica. The Library undertakes to collect all materials pertinent to Jamaica, whether by purchasing items or by soliciting donations.

The Jamaican National Bibliography is produced by the staff of the National Library of Jamaica.

Arrangement

The bibliography is arranged according to the Dewey Decimal Classification, 23rd edition, and catalogued according to the Anglo–American Cataloguing Rules, 2nd edition 1998 revision and the Resource Description and Access (RDA).

It is arranged in two sections by years: a classified subject section and an index arranged alphabetically by author and title etc.

The most detailed information about an item is given in the Classified Subject Section. This includes the fullest form of the name the author uses in his/her works, the full title, edition, place of publication, publisher, date of publication, number of pages, types of illustrations, series, size, notes, ISBN, ISSN, price and binding.

A shorter entry is given in the Index where the entries are arranged alphabetically under the name of the author, title or corporate body. The edition of the work, the publisher, price and binding, ISBN and class number are also included in the Index.
